Yom HaZikaron (May 11, 2016): "The Day of Remembrance for the Fallen Soldiers of Israel and Victims of Terrorism" is Israel's official Memorial Day, enacted into law in 1963. While Yom Hazikaron has been traditionally dedicated to fallen soldiers, commemoration has now been extended to civilian victims of political violence, Palestinian political violence, and terrorism in general.

Yom Ha'Atzmaut (May 12, 2016): is founded on the declaration of the establishment of the State of Israel by the Jewish leadership headed by David Ben-Gurion on 14 May 1948. Independence was declared eight hours before the end of the British Mandate of Palestine, which was due to finish on 15 May 1948. The operative paragraph of the Declaration of the Establishment of State of Israel of 14 May 1948 expresses the declaration to be by virtue of our natural and historic right and on the strength of the resolution of the United Nations General Assembly. The operative paragraph concludes with the words of Ben-Gurion, where he thereby declares the establishment of a Jewish state in Eretz Israel, to be known as the State of Israel.
